How the programme works

Participants take part in teams of up to 10 accompanied by an experienced instructor.

Accommodation is at the Hillary Outdoors Education Centre in Karaka Bay in cabins of 4-6 students. The site is supported by communal kitchens, classrooms and lounge spaces. Every participant contributes to camp life through daily duties which include cooking some meals, dishes duty and cleaning.

Some nights are spent away from the Centre on expedition; either camping or utilising a DOC hut.

Programme features

- ✓ Outdoor Activity Days: participants decide on the day's activity alongside their instructor. Activities may include; sea kayaking, coasteering, rock climbing, abseiling, high ropes, snorkeling, surf kayaking and many more...
- ✓ Expedition Days: Explore the further reaches of the island by foot or sea kayak. The programme includes two expeditions - a two-day expedition in the first week, and a three-day expedition in the second week as the finale!
